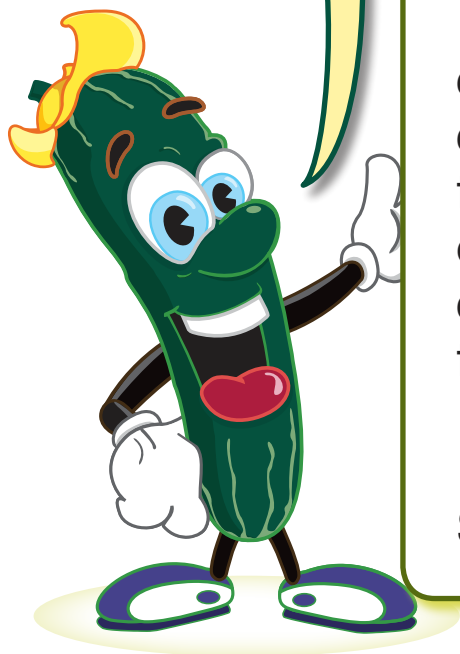


FROM FARM TO FORK

How are pickles made at the Mt. Olive Pickle Company?



The first step is to buy lots of cucumbers from farmers. Some cucumbers are put in huge tanks. The tanks are filled with salt water. The cucumbers stay in the tanks for months. Other cucumbers skip this step.

Next, the cucumbers are washed and cut. Some are cut into chips. Some are cut into spears. Some are left whole. Then they are put in jars. Pickle juice is poured on top. The jars are capped. After the cucumbers are cooked, labels are put on the jars.

Lastly, the jars are packed and shipped. Soon people can buy the pickles at stores!
