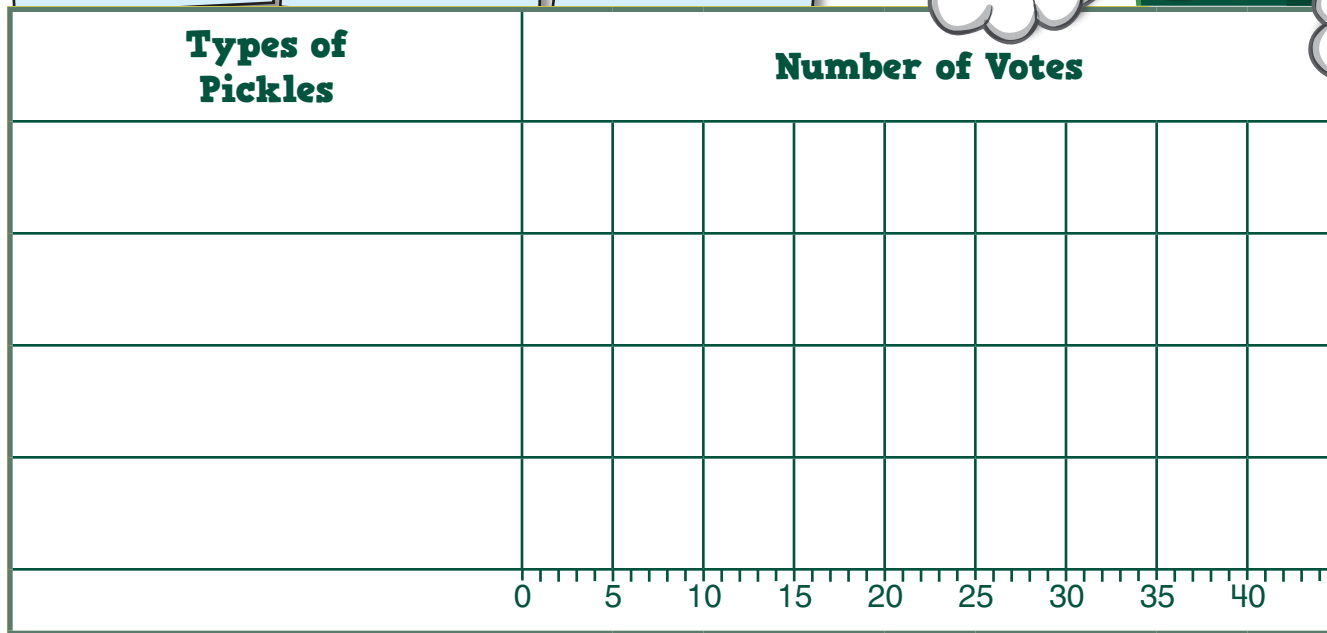
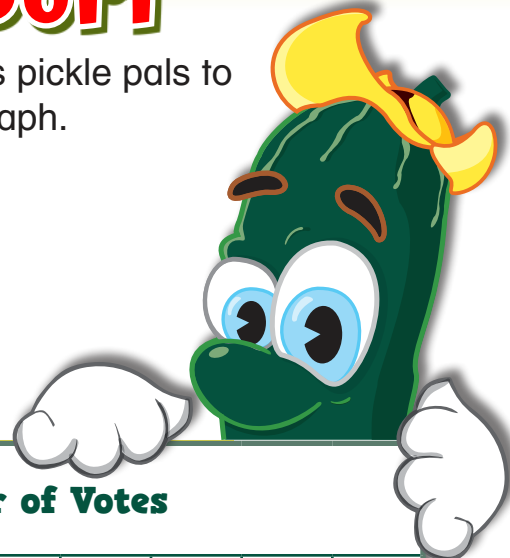


# The Pickle Report
